Recruitment for all courses begins in **May 2024 and the deadline is 31**st **August 2024** and consists of several stages before your arrival Poland.

BEFORE COMING TO POLAND

- First you have to write an email to us in May and say in which course you are interested.
 Then we will send you a registration form to fill in (remember to write all the details from your passport and the name of the course you want to take)
- Please send back the scan or photo of the filled form to sjpdc@uni.lodz.pl and please also attach the following documents:
 - 1. A scan of your passport (page with the photo)
 - 2. A scan of your secondary school certificate (Atestat, Apostille)
 - 3. A document issued by Ministry of Education which states that you are allowed to study (only Belarus citizens)
 - 4. The secondary school curriculum (only Belarus citizens)
 - 5. A scan of your parents' statement of consent if you are underage (under 18) at the time of your arrival in Poland
- In another email please state the city of the Polish consulate in which you will apply for the visa
- Only then you will receive from us a letter of preliminary acceptance for the course (in English) and a bank account number for the payment of the fee
- After you pay the fee please send us a scan of the bank payment- deadline is 15th August.
- When we receive the confirmation from the University Finances that your payment is in our bank account (it usually takes approx.2 weeks) we will send you a certificate (in Polish) addressed to the Polish Embassy. You need this certificate to apply for a student visa at the Polish consulate. You will also get a document from us confirming the reservation of your accommodation in our student hostel. You should also take this document with you when you go to the Embassy
- If you do not get a visa please read carefully the procedure of the refund

AFTER COMING TO POLAND

- As soon as you arrive, you should come to our school at 16/18 Kopcińskiego Street from 8 am to 2 pm room 2.10 /second floor/
- You should have with you all the **original documents**:
 - o secondary school certificate
 - the secondary school certificate legalisation (ask for it at the Embassy or Ministry of Education)
 - Ministry of Education document with allowance to study
 - o the secondary school curriculum
 - o parents' statement of consent (if under 18)
 - health certificate stating there are no indications against your participation in the course
 - o two photos
 - 60-70 PLN for a student insurance against accidents
- You go to our student hostel at 21/23 Matejki Street any time you want it is open 24h/7
- Remember you do not have to reserve a place at the hostel. After you pay the fee you automatically get a place at the hostel
